Symphony No 5 in C Minor, Op 67 Beethoven began to sketch this symphony in 1804, completed the score in the spring of 1808, and conducted the first performance on December 22 of that year in Vienna The score calls for two flutes and piccolo, two oboes, two clarinets, two bassoons and contrabassoon, two horns, two trumpets, three
